She goes through some of the important things her and her team are accomplishing with suicide prevention in veterans.</p> <p>Their focus areas include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Identifying service members in the community. • Screening for suicide risk. • Promoting the care and transition of veterans. • Creating connection and access to resources for veterans. • Increasing legal means for safety • Safely planning for those at elevated risk of suicide by giving them plans and ways of coping. <p>They are looking to work with other agencies in the community to get veterans care and support by building an awareness in the community of the needs specific to veterans.</p> <p>If you would like to contact Alicia, you can reach her at Alicia.Hyatte@va.gov</p> <p>Mental Health First Aid:</p> <p>The Coalition last year sponsored several trainer’s certification for MHFA. We are willing to promote and aid with trainer partnership.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Syndi Bultman volunteered to host a MHFA training in October or November. <p>UCF Restores Training:</p> <p>This peer support program teaches students how to recognize and assist individuals that have stress injuries.
