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Brian Massey goes through the State required trainings and exercises (See presentation) Medical Response Surge Exercise (MRSE) – Planned for April Syndi Bultman showed support for preforming the MRSE in the rural hospitals. Others in Chat agreed. Gloria Graham Suggested a whole region evacuation with a big weather event like Ian as the scenario and involving multiple health systems. Kevin G – Proposed collaborating with another HCC and having one region do a surge out and another surge in. Adam DuBois – Agreed with Kevin on involving another HCC and showed support for having the scenario be based in the rural counties. **Kelly Ashworth** showed support for having the smaller, inland hospitals involved. Adam DuBois suggested having a lake Okeechobee breech scenario. Peggy Brown proposed having a small working group involving rural areas. The Task Force agreed to have exercise performed in April. Crisis Standard of Care – Planned for December with All Clear TTX and perhaps focusing on scarcity of staff. Chemical Surge Exercise – Planned for February with either All Clear or in collaboration with the Florida HCCs. The TTX will be based on the required Chemical Surge Annex. Pediatric Surge Exercise - Planned for March and based on the required Pediatric Surge Annex. This will be in collaboration with the Pediatric Task force and the Pediatric Clinical Advisor, Niki Shimko. All Clear will be conducting eight tabletop exercises throughout the year starting with Prepare and Protect: A Workplace Violence Discussion Based Exercise on August 29<sup>th</sup> 2023 and Crafting Exercises Excellence on September 20<sup>th</sup> 2023 (*See presentation*) Joh Gountas requested we look at different vendors for other trainings. Kevin G suggested at looking at a climate related topic. Adam DuBois put forward the idea of having a scenario involving a prison. This scenario would have about 1000 patients and involve law enforcement as well. Trainings from Other Task Forces will include UCF Restores, MHFA Training, and Pediatric Transportation Devices training. (See presentation) Kevin G offered the Lee County EM situation room for the UCF training. The Florida HCCs are offering additional online trainings.
