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- I. Call to order at 2:02pm
 - II. Brian Massey introduced the Healthcare Coalition, our mission, purpose, and our Executive Council members.
 - III. Speaker Presentation
 - **Dr. Kristine Taylor**; the Executive Director, for the Center for Professional Excellence & Inquiry at Stanford Medicine Children's Health spoke on [T.R.A.I.N.](#) (Triage by Resource Allocation for Inpatients program) Her presentation can be found [here](#).
 - **Stacy Gad**, a licensed Occupational Therapist and **Jennifer Costello**, a Registered Nurse and founders of Aging Advocate speaking Emergent Situations Involving Persons with Dementia with REACH. Their presentation can be found [here](#).
 - **Sgt Wanda Hainley**; Human Trafficking Liaison Hendry County Sheriff's Office speaking on what is human trafficking, what to watch for, how to prevent it. Sgt Hainley will be conducting a more in-depth training on July 18th. You can find mor information and register [here](#).
 - IV. Coalition updates
 - **COOP (Continuity of Operations Plan)/CEMP (Comprehensive Emergency Management Planning)** Visit the Florida Healthcare Coalitions website to access these tools [here](#). You can contact coalition@hpcswf.com to set up a plan and provide you and your agency access to the application.
 - **The Pediatric Task Force:**
 - With the approval of the Executive Council, the remaining Pediatric Devices for Lee County EMS have purchased, as they did not have enough to supply every ambulance.
 - The first use of the Pediatric Disasters in Seconds MCI Kit was during a Golisano Children's Hospital MCI Drill with several good lessons learned.

- The task force is looking at the gaps that were discovered during the Pediatric Surge Exercise and will help close those gaps including promoting the use of PECC (Pediatric Emergency Care Coordinators)
- **Training & Exercises:**
 - The Incident Command System (ICS) For Healthcare Leadership training was recently conducted, and will be built upon it with an Activation 101 that will introduce members to their respective DOH and EM
 - The task force would like to look at one specific topic and escalate it from seminars to workshops then tabletop exercises and lead into Drills, functional and full-scale exercises.
 - Two radiological preparedness trainings will be scheduled for next year:
 - the PER-370 that provides hospital first receivers/ healthcare workers with essential knowledge and skills to assist them when responding to a radiological/nuclear weapon of Mass Destruction (WMD) incident in the safest manner possible for themselves and victims.
 - The PER-332 which provides fundamental knowledge and situational awareness to safely and effectively perform or assist population-monitoring duties at Community Reception Centers (CRCs) or similar facilities after a radiological/nuclear incident has occurred.
- **Resources & Gaps:**
 - The assets the Coalition has purchased or funded over the years are being put together in a usable inventory list. This Task Force will help to establish the policies and procedure for requesting these assets.
- **Mental Health Task Force:**
 - This task force is being sunset and combined into the new Priority Populations Task Force.
 - the Individuals in Crisis And Group Crisis Intervention Training has been completed with 13 of the reserved 50 seats taken.
 - The books for the MHFA (Mental Health First Aid) trainings have been supplied to members of Charlotte County DoH who have been providing training.
 - We will continue to promote the wellbeing of healthcare workers and first responders.
- **Priority Populations Task Force** (our new Task Force):
 - This group will look at topics like hearing and sight impaired, dementia, autism, dialysis, electrical dependent, and any other areas that the task force deems appropriate including mental health.
