	 presented *Pricing decreased from 70k to 60k* Alena Scandura – Please provide more details on what exactly is needed to do and how much it would cost for the refurbishment and upfit. Caitie Eck – Collier has been good about sharing resources within and outside of the region. Tashawna Gaines – How would the driver situation work with the sharing of the resources. Dan Summers - Made a commitment to have a driver available when the bus is shared at no charge. However, if the partner submits for FEMA supplemental aid
