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Peggy Brown – Are there any priorities or anything that FAN is looking to accomplish?
Niki Shimko – The major focus is having a Peds disaster plan and they are also involved in
identifying PECCS in agencies as well as major collaborations with EMS for children.
They are looking to have more representation in FAN from different regions throughout the State.
Peggy Brown – Asked Niki to speak a bit on Emergency Medical Services for Children (EMSC) initiative?
Niki Shimko – EMSC is a program working to improve health care in the field for children. It's goal is to ensure that pediatric patients receive the best care possible in the prehospital setting. Kids are often viewed as "little adults," children actually have very different and specific medical needs.
