Meeting	<p>Brian Massey gives an overview the Pediatric Task Force’s Purpose.</p> <p>Niki Shimko previewed her presentation for the Quarterly Membership meeting on Feb 7th. Niki will speak on the importance of keeping pediatrics in mind and what the gaps are for pediatric patients.</p> <p>Pediatric Training & Exercise: The kits have been approved for purchase. Members have sowed interest in using these kits for their own exercise. The Coalition will promote and aid in including these kits in as many trainings and exercises as possible. Kits comes with 30 scenarios ready to go and checklists that can be used after the exercise.</p> <p>Pediatric Surge Annex: The Coalition decided to update the state provided Pediatric Surge Annex this year. It was requested by the Executive Council that some edits be made. A section that was questioned was the Family Reunification. Lynne Stickley comments that 2022 EM Standards for joint commission requires hospitals to have a Family Reunification plan. An article on this topic was shared with all.
