Meeting	<p>Brian Massey opens with an overview of the Resources and Gaps Task Force’s Purpose.</p> <p>Last year’s prioritized Gaps and Hazards: The 2022-2023 HVA prioritized gaps and hazards were listed. In response the Coalition developed a number of trainings, some of the ones still to come are:</p> <p><u>Mental Health First Aid (MHFA):</u> Several MHFA trainers were certified, and a training will be conducted on February 28th -29th, 2024 by one of these trainees. (<u>Register here.</u>) Lorie Jackson - requested having more members be certified particularly in the rural areas to fill the need. Other members present agreed.</p> <p><u>The Pediatric Surge Exercise:</u> This tabletop exercise named Tiny Troopers Emergency Drill this exercise will be held on March 27th, 2024. (<u>Register here.</u>) The Coalition has purchase Pediatric Training Exercise Kits. These kits will be lent out to agencies conducting exercises and will encourage the inclusion of pediatric patients in trainings.</p>
